**This is important information on changes in your Blue MedicareRx Enhanced and Blue MedicareRx Value coverage.**

We previously sent you the Evidence of Coverage (EOC) which provides information about your coverage as an enrollee in our plans. This notice is to let you know there were errors in your EOC. 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**Important Message About What You Pay for Insulin** - You won't pay more than \$35 for a one-month supply of each insulin product covered by our plan, no matter what cost-sharing tier it's on, even if you haven't paid your deductible (if applicable).

**Important Message About What You Pay for Vaccines** - Our plan covers most Part D vaccines at no cost to you, even if you haven't paid your deductible (if applicable). Call Member Services for more information.
